New PERISKAL APP for navigation on tablets

Besides the App for viewing the PC application as showed in our last newsletter, we have now also a real App for navigation. The Periskal Mobile Navigation App is a standalone application, compliant with the upcoming regulation of the Rhine Commission. The App uses the same well known Inland ECDIS charts of Periskal.

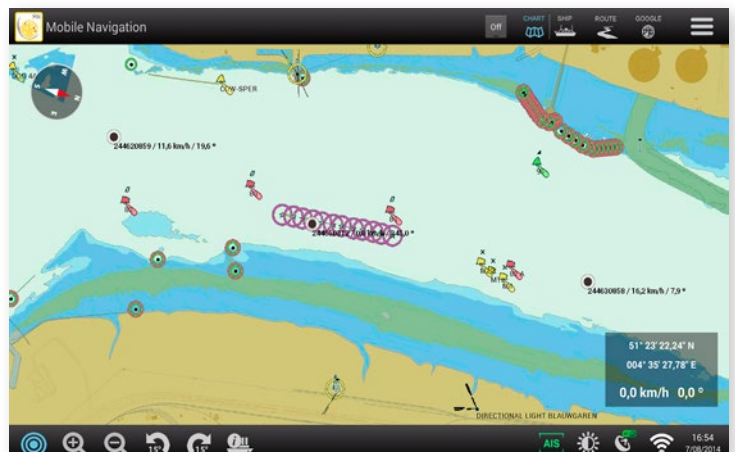
The App can be used to connect to an Inland AIS transponder via a fixed cable connection (USB). Fixed cable connections between an Inland AIS and Inland ECDIS are mandatory by the Rhine Commission. The App is already available for Android and soon also for iOS.

The Periskal App fulfills all the needs for navigation onboard and is sold for little money via the Webstores like Google Play and iTunes. Navigation on tablets can be a good alternative for PC on board of small vessels, push boats and for people who do not like to or want to navigate on PC.

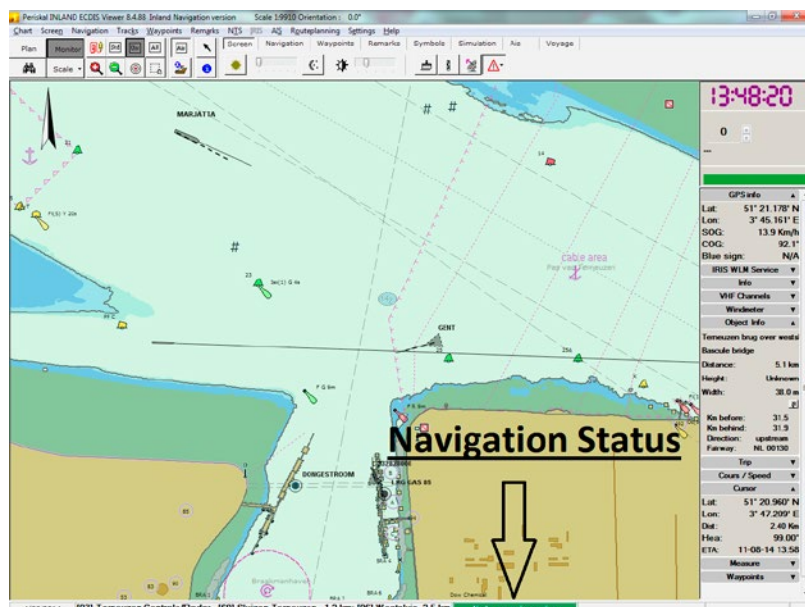


New hotkeys for changing the navigation status on board

The new regulation for Inland ECDIS on the Rhine makes it mandatory to change the 'navigation status' every time. Not only the Rhine Commission but also other countries require that you send out the proper status of navigation.

Via a hotkey it was already possible to go directly to the Dynamic Ship settings of the Inland AIS.

In the new test version of the software, also on this summer DVD, we have made a 'hotkey' for the navigation status which allows a direct and easy control. A green color is representing a correct setting of the Inland AIS while a red color requires a service of the cable connection between the Inland AIS and Inland ECDIS.

How to install the update ?

WINDOWS XP USERS should contact our helpdesk first before installing the update !!

- Close all applications
- Insert the update DVD
- Automatically you will get a window in which you can click on 'execute SETUP.EXE'
- The next window appears where you can choose the desired installation language
- Follow the instructions on the screen
- Restart your PC
- Now you can open Periskal Viewer
- Your charts will be installed automatically
